to empower PE teachers and coaches who have been undervalued despite being the cornerstone of sports development in our country.

The Ministry has endorsed our proposal that state ranking 2024-25 teams/individual athletes, coaches/PE teachers be trained at the foundational level under the **Sports Authority of India (SAI) Training Programme**. This comprehensive training initiative aims to:

- Provide world-class training standards aligned with Olympic requirements
- Recognize and elevate the status of PE teachers and coaches
- Build a robust foundation for India's Olympic 2036 aspirations

ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION CRITERIA

We require comprehensive data collection from all affiliated units for the **top 3 coaches/PE teachers in Olympic sports**(as per the attached list) for the state championship 2024-25, covering both individual and team sports categories.

These selected coaches/PE teachers will undergo specialized training in collaboration with the Sports Authority of India, ensuring they are equipped with cutting-edge coaching techniques and methodologies essential for developing Olympic-caliber athletes.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. **Deadline** : Please submit the completed details by **19th August 2025**
2. **Format** : Use the attached form for each coach/PE teacher which are duly signed by **unit competent authority**
3. **Submission Mode**: Email to info23-27@sgfi.org.in
4. **Authorization** : All submissions must be duly signed by the competent authority of the unit
5. **Contact Person**: SGFI Headquarters for any queries

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Only coaches/PE teachers who have achieved top 3 rankings in state championship 2024-25 are eligible (Under 14,17 - BOYS & GIRLS).
- All Olympic sports disciplines as per the attached list are covered
- Both individual and team sport coaches/PE teachers should be included
- Incomplete submissions will not be processed
- All details must be submitted as per the attached format
- **Any form submitted without the signature of the competent authority of the unit will not be considered for processing**
- **All forms must be routed through the official email IDs of the respective units to the SGFI Head Office. Direct submissions from individuals will not be entertained.**
